

Astor Special Opportunities Grants Available for Students' Special Activities

The Northeast Harbor Library makes Astor Special Opportunities Grants available to all **full-time Mount Desert Elementary School and Town of Cranberry Isles School students**.

These grants support individual students pursuing activities and learning opportunities in the arts, natural and physical sciences, social sciences, and personal development programs.

The application **deadline** is **May 15, 2025**. Students may receive only one Astor award during their elementary school career.

The maximum amount awarded per student will be the lesser of (a) one half of the program cost or (b) \$500. Grant checks are issued to institutions or teachers, not to the student applicants.
