#### Making plaster casts of tracks:

#### Included in box:

18 track molds- Mammals you are likely to see in this area18 Stir sticks**9** Yogurt cups

#### Additional Materials You will need:

Plaster of Paris Water Paper plates paper cups

#### **Directions:**

Mix 3 parts powder to 1 part water, (1cup plaster, 1/3cup water) Add plaster **to** water in thirds, stir between additions

Stir to thick smooth yogurt-like consistency (you may not use the whole cup of powder) Stir quickly so it doesn't set up in container

Scoop/pour plaster into center of mold in thirds, shake mold gently to settle and fill all the small areas between pours

Fill to the top of mold so the animal and print type will be on your cast

Set aside to dry- 30min-1hr, times vary due to size of mold and consistency of plaster, it will warm as it dries **do not remove** while still warm or wet

Flip mold and gently push track out of the rubber

#### Clean up note:

(Yogurt containers and stir sticks can be reused)

Scrape excess off stir sticks then allow extra plaster to dry in containers

When dry, extra plaster can be tapped out into trash

#### Suggestions for larger groups:

Do a test run beforehand to get the mix right and get an idea of drying time Do another for your group to demo the process Set out paper cups with 1 cup power Set out yogurt cups with ½ cup water

have a wash-up station ready plastic on floor if needed

#### Take it on the road:

This method can be used "in the field" bring a baggie of plaster and some water on your next hike or trip to the beach, you can mix right in the bag, add water slowly, have an extra baggie of plaster to thicken your mix if needed. It might be hard to wait, your track may pick up particles from the soil, you could try using the plastic to line the track but it will be hard to tell if you are getting it in
